Sound options

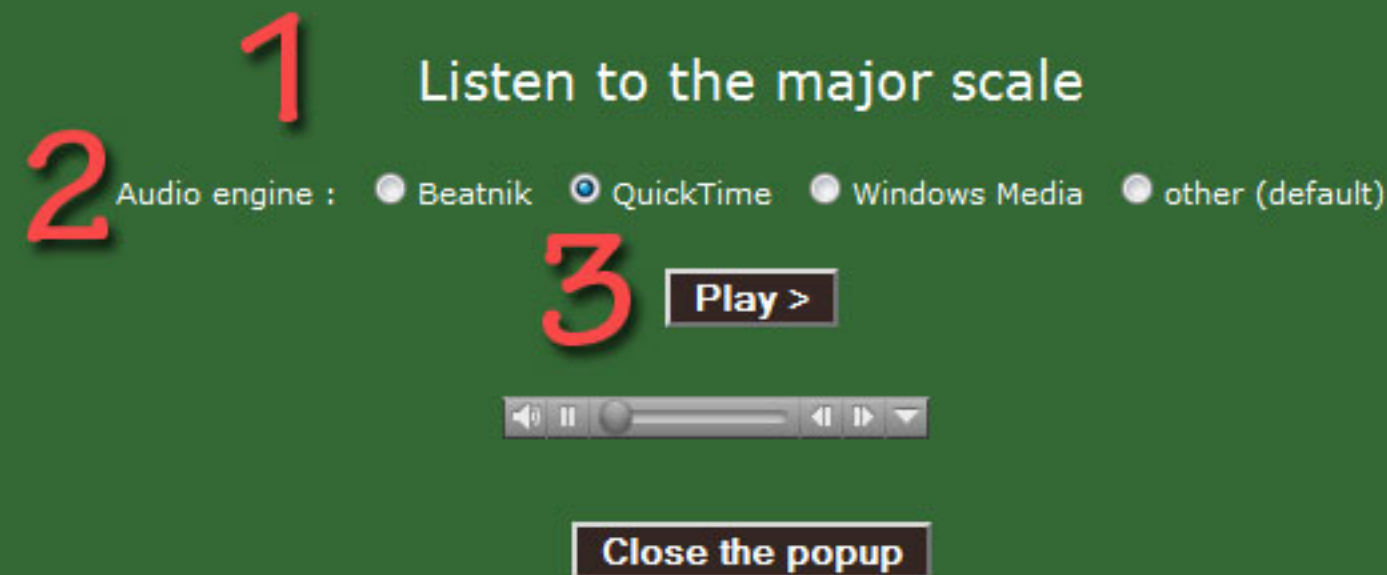
To listen the scale, click on...

To listen a single note in particular, click on its name !

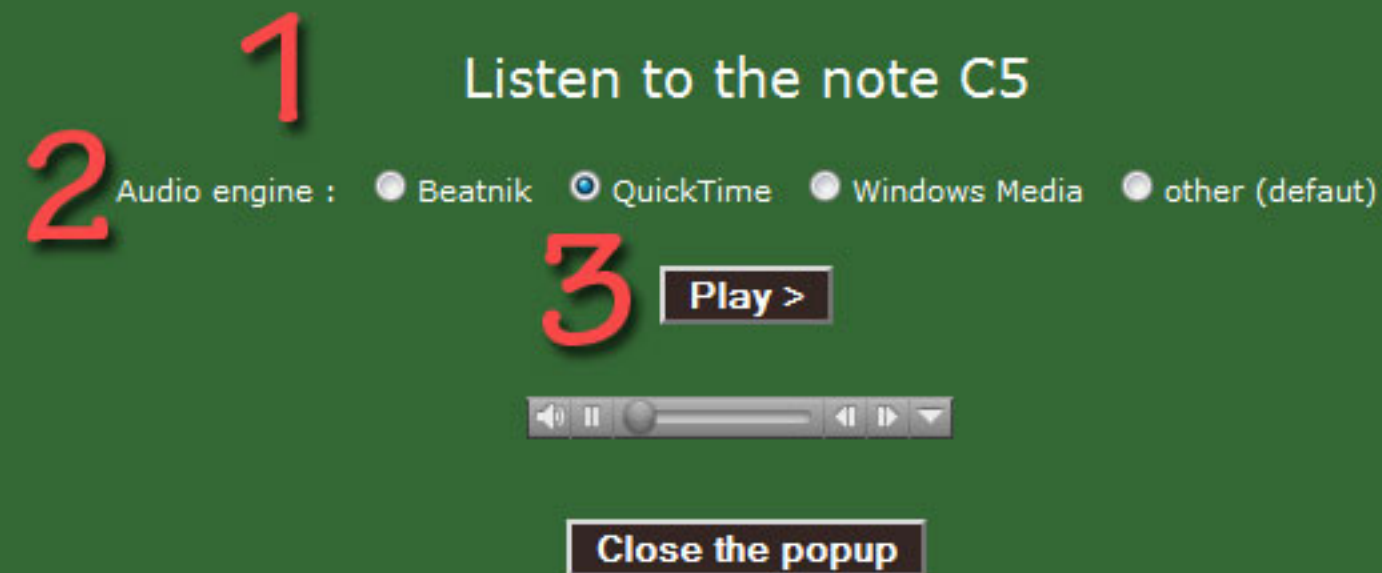
1. You can see your previous choices (and you can modify them)
